Higher Education and Training: Provide figures for tangible outcomes such as number of student enrolments and graduations, internships or WIL learning placements, employment outcomes, PhD candidacies, national outcomes in terms of closing-the-gap or gender balances or improved rates for STEM participation, etc. Please also note if marginalised groups have been included in outcomes.

Community Engagement: Provide figures for tangible outcomes where applicable such as community groups to directly benefit and their approximate numbers, growth projected in jobs created, local, State or nation-wide positive outcomes, or informative material created and its outreach etc.
